 **COVID-19 RULES Fall 2021 Horseback Riding Programs**





**RULES:**

- 1. Mail all forms and payment to me. DO NOT HAND ME PAYMENT. MAIL IN MONROE COUNTY takes 24 HOURS for me to receive payment. Go to my web site and pay with pay-pal. YOU DO NOT NEED A PAY-PAL ACCOUNT. Any debit or credit card works. DO NOT HAND ME ANYTHING, PLEASE.**
- 2. YOU MUST BE ON-TIME. YOU are on a schedule for a reason, please follow it. I cannot have too many cars**

parked in the parking lot at one time, and we need to be prepared for your arrival and departure. All the specials and extras and long days at the stables ended with the start of COVID. I cannot have large groups of volunteers. Sadly this part of the stables is fading due to the limit of the number of people I can have here at ONE TIME. Arrive and depart on-time. Please do not arrive early, just on-time.

3. Dropping off or picking-up a rider, PLEASE REMAIN IN YOUR CAR, DO NOT GET OUT OF YOUR CAR. MASKS ON. NO YOU CANNOT WORK OUT OF YOUR CAR DURING YOUR RIDERS LESSON TIME. NO YOU CANNOT WANDER AROUND THE STABLES PARKING LOT OR THE STABLES.
4. Temperatures are taken on all riders before they leave the car. Pull in parking lot, veering to the right, then steer to the left, proceed to steps in parking lot, stop, mask on and I will run out and take your temperature. Rider exits car with MASK ON. If you are driving in for a lesson or a TRAIL RIDE, park at the coned spots and wait for me to run out and take your temperature.
5. MASKS STAY ON (NOT everyone is vaccinated!!!) Wash hands at the wash station. Proceed to the sterilized ASTM riding helmets, mount on the horse awaiting your arrival, and proceed for a warm-up, the riding begins.
6. Keep MASKS ON, Dismount, place your helmet in the bin marked dirty helmets and proceed to wash hands in the hand washing area.

7. Everyone must have a fanny pack with masks, hand sanitizer, sunscreen, bug spray, sunglasses, water bottle, etc. WE CANNOT GIVE YOU PERSONAL CARE ITEMS.
8. Please plan absent times in advance, email with changes and we can accommodate. DO NOT ASK ME TO CHANGE A SCHEDULE WITHIN HOURS. I am with students DO NOT BE RUDE. I cannot hire a secretary to keep track of your DISORGANIZATION....PLEASE, get it together!!!!!!!!!!!!!!
9. Birthday Celebrations are best when I know in an email in advance. Obviously, cupcakes and salvatores pizza would be fine. Email me, DO NOT TELL ME AND EXPECT ME TO REMEMBER....WE have an enormous amount of birthday requests each year!!
10. Please text me and let me know of an absence. DO NOT CALL. You are competing with 35 emails every day on average and over 30 calls....WHO IS ANSWERING THE PHONE???

-  Registration for Fall Riding Programs and Lesson Programs are enclosed in this packet of information.
-  Cancellations are done 24 hours prior to your scheduled lesson, or you will be charged a full lesson fee. Be courteous of our time and the horses!!!!
-  If you miss a class, we schedule a make-up.
-  Refunds: IF the stables has to close and you have 8 riding credits you paid for fall 2021, then you will be credited your riding fees upon the stables re-opening. I am NOT writing refund checks. Riding credits, absolutely!

-  **Billing: If we have to request funds and send more than 1 bill, you will be charged an office fee of \$50.00 per late payment.**
  -  **Choose from 23 different horses available English or Western for your riding time!**
  -  **You must ride 4x per month minimum & you must be consistent.**
  -  **Riding available: Indoor/outdoor arenas, first and lower pastures, cross-country course.**
  -  **PLEASE DO NOT REGISTER IF YOU CANNOT FOLLOW THE RULES. DO NOT TEXT ME AND ASK ME THE SAME QUESTIONS PROVIDED IN THIS FORM. READ THE FORM.**

## **+ Adult Riding Programs (ages 18 and up):**

- ❖ **Riding Level: Beginner & Beginner-Intermediate Classes**
  - ❖ **Dates: Thursdays: September, October, November & December: 9/23, 30; 10/7, 14, 21, 28; 11/4, 11, 18; 12/2, 9, 16, and 23, 2021**
  - ❖ **Times: 3 p.m. to 9 p.m., EVERY 45 MINUTES, 3 p.m. to 3:45 p.m., 3:45 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. and so on...**
  - ❖ **Riding Tuition: 13 classes x \$55.00 per class = \$715.00 Due with Completed Registration Form.**
  - ❖ **Doubling Riding: For Example, 3 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. x 2 lessons = \$110.00 per class x 13 classes = \$1,430.00 DUE WITH COMPLETED REGISTRATION FORM.**
  - ❖ **Monthly Payments MUST be made and are DUE BY THE 1<sup>st</sup> OF EACH MONTH.**

## **+ Family Riding Programs (ages 4+and up):**

Mother-Daughter or Mother-Son; Father-Daughter or Father-Son; Grandparents and grandchildren; Siblings riding together- Sister-Sister, Sister-Brother, Brother-Brother.

  - Time Options: 3 p.m. to 7:45 p.m., EVERY 45 MINUTES, 3 p.m. to 3:45 p.m., 3:45 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. and so on.....**
  - ❖ **Riding Tuition: 13 classes x \$50.00 = \$650.00 x 2 riders = \$1,300.00 DUE WITH COMPLETED REGISTRATION FORM.**
  - ❖ **Monthly payment MUST be made and are DUE BY THE 1<sup>st</sup> OF EACH MONTH.**

## **+ Children's & Pee Wee Horseback Riding Programs(ages 2+): 40 minutes of riding time**

This program is for younger riders unable to participate in a 3 hour program.

  - ❖ **Time Options: Choose a 40 minute time slot on Thursday between the hours listed below. We will do what we can to accommodate your preferred time.

  - ❖ **Riding Tuition: 13 Thursday x \$60.00 per class = \$780.00 Due with a Completed Registration Form.**

## **+ Youth Horseback Riding Programs(ages 5 to 21) : 1.5, 2.5 or 3.5 hours of riding time?**

This program is for mature riders who are able to participate in a 3 hour program. Same time, Same Day, Same Schedule.

- ❖ **Riding Level: Beginner & Beginner-Intermediate Classes**
  - ❖ **Dates: Wednesdays: September 22, 29; October 6, 13, 20, 27; November 3, 10, 17; December 1, 8, 15 22, 2021**
  - ❖ **Dates: Thursdays: September 23, 30; October 7, 14, 21, 28; November 4, 11, 18; December 2, 9, 16, 23, 2021**
  - ❖ **Dates: Fridays: September 24; October 1, 8, 15, 22, 29; November 5, 12, 19; December 3, 10, 17, 2021 and 12/23 Thursday Christmas Party**
  - ❖ **Time Options: Choose a time: Wednesdays, 1pm to 5:30pm; Thursdays, 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and Fridays 2pm to 5:30pm.**
  - ❖ **Riding Tuition:**
    - **Option #1: \*Children's/Youth: 3 Hour Horseback Riding Program, Riding 1.5 hours each lesson, 1.5 hours of horse time = \$55.00 per lesson X 13 days = \$715.00**
    - **Option #2: \*Children's/Youth: 4.0 Hour Horseback Riding Program, Riding 2.5 hours each lesson, 1.5 hour horse time = \$75.00 per lesson x 13 Thursdays = \$975.00**
    - **Option #3: \*Children's/Youth: 5.0 Hour Horseback Riding Program, Riding 3.5 hours, 1.5 hours of horse time = \$90.00 per lesson x 13 Thursdays = \$1,1700.00**
    - **Option #4: \*Children's/Youth: 5.0 Hour Horseback Riding Program, Choose 2 DAYS from Wed., Thurs. or Fri., Riding 3.5 hours, 1.5 hours of horse time, 2x each week, \$175.00 per week x 4 = \$700.00 per month**
    - **Option #5: \*Children's/Youth: 5.0 Hour Horseback Riding Program, Thursdays Ride 3pm to 8pm, 4pm to 9pm, 4.0 Hours Horseback riding, Dismissal is at 8pm or 9pm, 1x a week \$200.00 week x 4 weeks = \$800.00 month**

- ❖ **Dates: Thursdays: September 23, 30; October 7,14, 21, 28; November 4, 11, 18; December 2, 9, 16, 23, 2021**
- ❖ **13 Single Classes, \$75.00 per class = \$975.00; 13 Double Riding classes, \$75.00 per class x 1.5 hours = \$150.00 x 13 = \$1,950.00**
- ❖ **Time Options: 2 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., 45 Minutes each rider is riding a SINGLE CLASS.**

**Trail Riding Dates and Times:**

September 23, 30; Oct. 7, 14, 21, 28: 5pm to 6pm/5pm to 6:30pm/6pm to 7pm/6pm to 7:30pm/6:30pm to 8pm/7pm to 8pm: Email your preferred time, date and number of riders.

**Columbus Day and Veterans Day Riding Program: 8am to 4pm/\$75.00 per day: October 11/November 11, 2021. Bring your own lunch and water bottle.**

**Other Horseback Riding Tuition fee's:**

- ❖ Prospective or Trial Lesson Ride = \$50.00 per rider for 45 minutes- Waiting List 2022
- ❖ Trail Riding with a trail Boss, 1 hour, \$60.00 per rider, 1 ½ hour, \$80.00 per rider.
- ❖ Spring Break Riding Program = Your rider can ride the day program, Wed., Thurs., and Fri. all day the week they are off in Feb. break and Spring Break Riding, \$100.00 per rider per day, per rider. Please email me dates and times. Each district is different.
- ❖ Individual Sibling Lessons = \$50.00 per rider for 45 minutes x 2 = \$100.00
- ❖ Individual horseback riding lesson = \$75.00, Double = \$150.00 for 1.5 hours
- ❖ Therapeutic Lessons- \$75.00 per rider, per 40 minute- Waiting List 2021

**Checks can be made out to: MOMS, Cash, Pay-Pal accepted by the stables web site. Pay –Pal Fee's are 3.06% X added to the total amount of riding tuition = Pay-Pal Fee**  
Example: \$100.00 riding tuition due x 3.06% = \$103.06 paid in full
